NEW DEVELOPMENT: We'll Be Getting Some New Neighbors!

The wooded 10-acre tract that abuts the utility easement behind the Park is under development. There are plans to build around 50 homes in that segment and it will be part of Foxwood overall.

At this time, the new section will not be part of either the original development of Foxwood or the newest additions.

The current amenities including our park, pools, tennis court and clubhouse will not be available to the new residents.

Our Board of Directors is planning to meet with the developer and find out how they plan to incorporate their clients into the Foxwood community. Our HOA will let us know how the new homes will impact us when the information becomes available.



Responsible Clean Up, Please Doing it wrong could result in a fine!

During this time of year, there is a lot more mowing and edging and trimming going on and that means lots of green debris to clean up.

Some residents use the storm drains as a convenient way to sweep all this stuff out of sight. It doesn't seem like it will hurt anything, right? However, it does inhibit efficient drainage when it rains. It impacts the entire water drainage system overall in a negative way.

Laws addressing this problem—using the storm drains for trash disposal—have been established. Anyone caught sweeping any kind of debris into a storm drain can be ticketed and fined.

To avoid having to pay a fine or appear in court, please do not use the storm drains for your yard debris.

The ATHLETIC FIELD is Here for You! Please keep this facility clean and safe.



The Athletic Field, located in our beautiful

neighborhood park, is there for the enjoyment of our residents that love to play baseball and soccer. We are happy that you use this facility and want to keep allowing our players to use it.

However, <u>trash and debris are continually littering the field.</u> There are trash receptacles available and they should be used. All bottles and other trash should be placed in the trash cans <u>before the teams</u> <u>and players leave the field</u>.

If more trash cans or trash bags are needed, please have your coaches or team leaders contact the Foxwood Phone Line (281-540-7430) and let us know. The HOA Board will be notified and we will work with you to provide them.

If the field cannot be kept clean and ready for use, the Board will have to consider limiting access or closing it down.

Back Yards Must Be Clean, Goo!
