## ALDINE INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT ADOPTS TAX RATE

ALDINE INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT ADOPTED A TAX RATE THAT WILL RAISE MORE TAXES FOR MAINTENANCE AND OPERATIONS THAN LAST YEAR'S TAX RATE; AND THE TAX RATE WILL EFFECTIVELY BE RAISED BY 10% PERCENT AND WILL RAISE TAXES FOR MAINTENANCE AND OPERATIONS ON A \$100,000 HOME BY APPROXIMATELY \$130.00 .

The adopted tax rate exceeds the district's current M&O rate by \$.13 cents. Because the M&O portion of the approved tax rate exceeds the district's compressed rate, the district is required to hold an election to obtain voter approval for the adopted rate. Following Dr. Clark's recommendation, Superintendent Dr. Wanda Bamberg recommended to the Board that it call for a tax ratification election. The Texas tax code requires that school districts that adopt a tax rate that exceeds the district's rollback rate must hold a tax ratification election to approve the adopted tax rate. Board members approved Dr. Bamberg's recommendation and set the tax ratification election for Tuesday, Aug. 31.

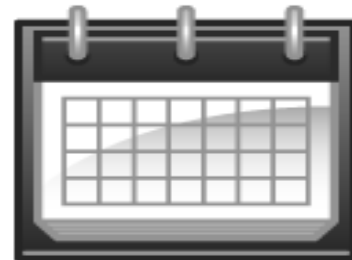
