## POOL REGISTRATION

Don't miss out on the opportunity to get your pass renewed this year! Pool registration will



be held at pool clubhouse on Saturday, April 21 from 10:00am— 4:00pm. If you have your passes from last year, please-bring them to validate for 2012. If you need to register or have lost your passes, you will need to fill out a new application, and bring a single photograph for each individual over the age of two.

For children passes, please make sure it is a recent photo. Each photograph should be

for the card holder only, no group pictures will be accepted. The photograph will not be returned; it will be affixed to the official pool pass for the current year. The size of photo should be equivalent to the size on your drivers license picture.

The only requirements to receive the pool pass is that you must be a Foxwood resident and have your fees paid for 2012. If you are renting or leasing the residence, the owner of that property must have their fees paid. Only members living at your residence or grandchildren are eligible. There are day passes available for guest at a minimal fee; inquire at pool when open.

If you miss the registration this month, pool applications will be available through CMS, the internet (Foxwoodhoa.net), and the pool area.


