Pool Opens in May: Now is the Time to Get Ready

- Pool Rules

The pool will open the first time on May 25<sup>th</sup>. Don't wait until the last minute to get ready for swim season:

- Save your old pool passes from last year so you can send them in for renewal.
- As soon as you pay your residential fees, you can apply for pool passes.
- Pool passes are free to all residents of Foxwood, sections 1 – 4.
- You must have a pool pass to swim and you must register/re-register each year.
- Registration forms are on the Foxwood website (<u>www.foxwoodhoa.net</u>). Instructions are on the form.
- A copy of the Pool Rules can be found on the website also.

## How to Rent the Foxwood Clubhouse for Your Event

The clubhouse located at the park near the pool in Foxwood, is available for residents to rent for their special events. It is perfect for small group celebrations, close to home, and inexpensive compared to any other venue available. Here are the basic guidelines for renting:

- Go to the Foxwood website (<u>www.foxwoodhoa.net</u>) and open the tab "Documents and Forms". At the bottom of the page, open the link to the Clubhouse Rental Form and print it out.
- Basic instructions for renting are printed on the form. Call the Foxwood Phone Line and request a date for your event leaving your name, address and phone number. Someone will return your call.
- The cost for renting is \$50.00 for rental fee and a \$100.00 deposit for cleaning and maintenance which will be refunded after your event and the premises have been inspected.
- Payment must be made in the form of a money order in the amount of \$150.00 made out to "Foxwood HOA".
