Your Foxwood HOA Board of Directors met Thursday, June Ilth. The following decisions were made based on the information that the City of Houston and Harris County shared at the mayor's news conference Thursday afternoon.

The HOA Board will continue to monitor the situation and review conditions again in <u>2 weeks</u>.

We will continue to issue updates as they occur.

• POOL, PARK and PLAYGROUND:

- Our public facilities remain closed at this time.
- The HOA Board and our Management Company (CMS) are consistently monitoring the mandates so that we can open up as soon as possible.
- We are recommending that residents go ahead and apply for pool passes by mail now so that as soon as the pool is open, you may immediately be eligible to use the pool.
- The picnic tables and benches are off limits and not to be used for your health and safety. People have been using them and we ask you not to as parks throughout the city and county remain closed.
- Team sports or other group activities are not allowed in the park at this time.
- The toddler play area remains locked.

• HOA BOARD and CMS:

- Employees continue to work in the CMS office. However, if you must make an inperson visit, you need to call and make an appointment first. No one is allowed in the office without an appointment.
